July 7, 1929 - April 10, 2024

Alfonse Bottino 94, of NYC and locally of Claverack, passed away peacefully on Wednesday April 10, 2024 at Columbia Presbyterian Hospital Cornell in New York. Born in The Bronx, NY on July 7, 1929, he was the son of the late Louis and Philomena (Perri) Bottino Alfonse earned two masters in English and Education from Iona and Hunter college respectively, served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War, Champion of New York City Baseball Little Fellas, was a School Teacher in the NYC School District for 33 years, real estate agent, stock broker, landlord of beach front properties, and 6 time nyc marathon runner. Affectionately known as “ Big Al,” and “ Shepherd.”

He is survived at home by his loving wife Greta (Hovde) Bottino, sons Roland and Oliver Bottino and his brother Louis Bottino. Alfonse was predeceased by brothers Joseph and John Bottino.
