Anthony Joseph Torchia, 74, of Philmont, died Thursday April 28, 2016 at his home. Born September 14, 1941 in Hudson, he was the son of the late Anthony and Alice (Stone) Torchia. He was a graduate of Hudson High School, and later served in the U.S. Navy during the Cuban Missile Crisis.
