Anthony P. Zibella, Jr. 81, of Hudson, died unexpectedly on Wednesday September 7, 2022 at his home. Born in Catskill, NY on November 30, 1940, he was the son of the late Anthony P. and Antoinette M. (Fantazzo) Zibella. Anthony was a hairstylist, who owned Lisa Marie Beauty Salon in Hudson. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, brother and friend.

Anthony provided leadership and valuable contributions to the local community. He was the Chairperson of the Private Industry Council of Columbia and Greene Counties and the Chairperson of the Columbia Greene Workforce Investment Board, both for 15 years. Sir Knight Anthony P. Zibella Jr. has been a member of the Hudson Knights of Columbus Council 316 for 57 years. Anthony served in many different ways; Fourth Degree Knight, Grand Knight, Program Director, Vocations Director, and currently held the position of the Financial Secretary for the past 37 years. He was a Past District Deputy of the 77th, 78th and 82nd districts and started a new council during that time.
