



## Isidora Concetta Schultz

June 10, 1938 - February 25, 2026

Isidora Concetta Schultz, 87, of Gallatin, NY, passed away peacefully at home on Wednesday, February 25, 2026, surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Brooklyn, NY on June 10, 1938, she was the daughter of the late Paul S. and Stefana (Piraino) diLuzio.

Isidora was employed by Western Electric for 14 years as a secretary. She later devoted many years of service as Court Clerk for the Towns of Gallatin and Livingston. Fred and Dora met in 1968 in Long Beach, NY, and were married on September 20, 1970, sharing 56 years of marriage together. In 1977, they moved their family to Ancram, NY, where they built a beautiful life and lasting legacy together.
