John "Johnny" Brodowski 93, of Hudson and lifelong resident, died peacefully on Saturday March 12, 2016 at Columbia Memorial Hospital. Born in Hudson on September 22, 1922, he was the son of the late John and Magdelina (Hornet) Brodowski. John graduated from Hudson High School and served in the U.S. Army during WWII and bravely did his part in the Normandy invasion receiving both the Silver Star for gallantry in action and the Purple Heart for Injuries sustained in fighting. He was the owner and operator of Johnny's Ideal Printing in Hudson for many years, and was a proud member of the American Legion Post #184 in Hudson.

He will be greatly missed by his loving wife of 70 years, Virginia E. (Phillips) Brodowski, at home, his sons J.
