Louis Vincent Ferraro 66, of Valatie died peacefully on Friday March 10, 2017 at Albany Medical Center. He was born in Kingston, NY on July 31, 1950 to Angela V. (Carlucci) Ferraro of Hudson and the late Louis J. Ferraro. After graduating Hudson High School, he served two tours of duty during the Vietnam War in the U.S. Army as an infantryman. Upon his return, he received an Associate's degree from Columbia-Greene Community College, and then earned his Bachelor's degree from Sienna College. He continued his education at SUNY Albany and received his Masters degree in political science. Louis worked for the U.S. Postal Service in Albany until his retirement. He was a devoted member of Sacred Heart - Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Roman Catholic Shrine in Hudson.
