February 5, 1930 - January 15, 2015

Robert E. Klein, Sr. 84, of Claverack, formerly of Hudson, died Thursday January 15, at his home in Claverack. Born February 5, 1930 in Woodbury, CT, he was the son of the late Alfred C. and Dora G. Galpin. Robert was a floor supervisor for the former Rainbow Girls Coat Co. in Springfield, MA for many years. He was a member of the New York Army National Guard in Hudson, and later served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War. He was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Hudson.

He is survived by his son Robert E. Jr. and (Elizabeth) Klein of Hopewell Junction, daughters: Bonnie L.
