Roger J. Edgley Sr. 83, of Columbiaville, NY died Thursday January 15, at St. Peters Hospital in Albany. Born on November 29, 1931, he was the son of the late Francis R. and Mary O'Brien Edgley. Roger was a graduate of Hudson High School and was a Veteran of the Korean War serving in the U.S. Navy. He was a truck driver for Harders Express in Claverack and later worked as a technician at the Columbia County Transfer stations in Hudson and Kinderhook. Roger was pre-deceased by his loving wife Virginia L. Hilton Edgley in on June 29, 2012. He was a member of the Church of St Joseph in Stuyvesant Falls, Stuyvesant Falls VFW, Teamsters Local 29, and a life member of the Stockport Fire Dept.
