Rudy J. Vyhnaneck 68, of Lantana FL died suddenly May 21, 2015. Rudy was born in Hudson NY on October 5, 1946, the son of Rudolph and Julia Rauscher Vyhnaneck of Mellenville. He graduated from Ockawamick Central School in 1964, and received an associate degree in computer programming from Chamberlayne Junior College in Boston and a bachelor of science degree in systems analysis from Barry University in Miami FL. Rudy served in the U.S. Army Security Agency in Europe during the Vietnam era, and worked for RCA on the AUTEK project on Andros Island in the Bahamas before moving to Lantana Florida in 1974. Rudy retired from a 30 year long career as a senior systems analyst for the South Florida Water Management District, specializing in Unix programming. Rudy was an avid collector of memorabilia, most especially, coins, as well as a prolific photographer. He loved exotic foods, gardening, and his many pets over the years.

Rudy is survived and was loved by his brother John Vyhnaneck and his wife Bess of Cambridge MA, by his grandson Derek Slife of Lantana FL, and by many cousins. He was predeceased by his daughter Kim. 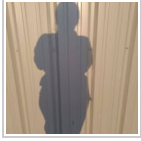
