Ruth Haines Yandow Hull, 96, of Elizaville, passed peacefully from this earth on June 8, 2025. She was born on February 2, 1929 in Oakland Gardens, Farmington, CT, to her loving parents Emil and Mildred Sharpe Yandow. She was a graduate of Farmington High School. In addition to her parents, Ruth was predeceased by her brothers Ronald and Emile (Eddie), and sister, Faith MacKesson. Also waiting to welcome her to Heaven are her beloved husband of nearly 60 years, Walter (Eddie) Hull, and their young son, Walter.

In keeping with a life devoted to work and caring for others, she ensured there were always seasonal plantings to honor the Blessed Mother. She was also known for her delicious but potent horseradish which she painstakingly ground by hand each spring in time for Easter.

Ruth loved hard work, telling it like it was, and, most of all, her family. She is survived by her children Linda (Edward) Colwell, Joseph (Karen) Hull, Faith (James) Foster, Edward (Deti) Hull, and Steven (Amy) Hull.
