May 11, 1951 - March 9, 2015

Vincent D. Sacco, Sr. 63, of Stuyvesant, NY passed away on Monday March 9, 2015 at Community Hospice in Columbia Memorial Hospital. Born May 11, 1951 in Hudson, he was the son of the late Benjamin and Opal (Horton) Sacco. Vince was a Columbia County Deputy Sheriff from 1972 until his retirement in 2011. He was the first canine handler for the Sheriff Dept. and was the owner of the first Canine Deputy "Sampson" . Vince enjoyed hunting and was an active NRA supporter. He was a loving husband, father and grandfather.

He is survived by his wife Patricia (Hawk) Sacco at home, son Vincent D. Sacco, Jr. of Stuyvesant, daughter Nicole and (Joshua) Dickinson of Harrisville, NY, brothers: Benny Joseph "BJ" and (Diane) Sacco and David Sacco, 2 sisters: Benita and (Joseph) Hotaling, Darlene and (Tony) Concra, grandchildren: Connor, Elena, Natalie and a host of Aunts, Uncles, Nieces and Nephews.
