We thought Aunt Ginna was the coolest, and she was!*

***Another time while I was staying at my grandparents' house during the summer, Aunt Ginna took me for a midnight run to White Castle. I never had White Castle before, nor had I ever gone out at midnight. She was so much FUN!*
